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## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are $1 / 4$ " unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!


## Cutting Instructions

## From Fabric A, cut:

five 5" x WOF strips. Subcut:
thirty-six 5" squares
four 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
twelve 4-1/2" squares
four $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
four 4-1/2" $\times 12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
five 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:
two 1-1/2" x 48-1/2" top/bottom border 1 pieces
two 1-1/2" $\times 50-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ side border 1 pieces

## From Fabric B, cut:

three 5" x WOF strips. Subcut:
twenty-four 5" squares
five 1-3/4" $\times$ WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:
two 1-3/4" x 50-1/2" top/bottom border 2 pieces
two $1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 53^{\prime \prime}$ side border 2 pieces
From Fabric C, cut:
three 5" x WOF strips. Subcut:
twenty-four 5" squares
six 4-1/2" $\times$ WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:
two 4-1/2" x 53" top/bottom border 3 pieces
two $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61^{\prime \prime}$ side border 3 pieces

## From Fabric D, cut:

two 5" x WOF strips. Subcut:
twelve 5" squares
From Fabric E, cut:
two 5" x WOF strips. Subcut:
twelve 5" squares
From the Binding Fabric, cut:
seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips

## Assemble the Half-Square Triangles (HSTs)

Step 1: Pair a $5^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A square with a 5 " Fabric B square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line, creating two half-square triangles (HSTs). Press toward the darker fabric. Trim to 4-1/2" square. Repeat to make a total of twenty-four A/B HSTs.


Step 2: Repeat Step 1 to make:

twenty-four A/C HSTs
twelve A/E HSTs


twenty-four B/C HSTs

twelve D/E HSTs

twelve A/D HSTs


Step 3: Arrange the HSTs and Fabric A squares and rectangles, as shown, in twelve rows. Pay close attention to the fabric placement and the HST orientation. Sew each row together, pressing the seams in opposite directions every other row. Sew the rows together in pairs, then sew pairs together. Continue in this way until you are sewing two quilt center halves together.

Step 4: Sew the top and bottom border 1 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the side border 1 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 5: Sew the top and bottom border 2 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the side border 2 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 6: Sew the top and bottom border 3 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the side border 3 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete. Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!

## Cutting Instructions

## From Fabric A, cut:

five 5" x WOF strips. Subcut:
thirty-six 5" squares
four 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
twelve 4-1/2" squares
four 4-1/2" $\times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
four $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
five $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim: two 1-1/2" $\times 48-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ top/bottom border 1 pieces two $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 50-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ side border 1 pieces

## From Fabric B, cut:

one 5" x WOF strip. Subcut:
four 5" squares
five 1-3/4" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:
two 1-3/4" x 50-1/2" top/bottom border 2 pieces
two $1-3 / 4$ " $\times 53^{\prime \prime}$ side border 2 pieces

## From Fabric C, cut:

three 5" x WOF strips. Subcut: twenty-four 5" squares
six 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:
two 4-1/2" $\times 53^{\prime \prime}$ top/bottom border 3 pieces
two 4-1/2" $\times 61^{\prime \prime}$ side border 3 pieces

## From Fabric D, cut:

two 5" x WOF strips. Subcut:
twelve 5" squares
From Fabric E, cut:
two 5" x WOF strips. Subcut:
twelve 5" squares
From Fabric F, cut:
three 5" x WOF strips. Subcut:
twenty 5" squares
From the Binding Fabric, cut:
seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips
